In case of registration with an admission certificate ("Zulassungsbescheinigung"), this document must be submitted at the secretariat of the chair by February 3, 2025 at the latest for the examinations on February 24, 2025 and by February 12, 2025 at the latest for the examinations on March 5, 2025. This also applies to admissions certificates of exchange students. After these dates, no more registrations will be accepted!

Deregistration:

A deregistration is mandatory (see examination regulations § 9). If the examination is not attended without valid reason, it is considered failed!
